Ready Kuit Charlesty Hats for the Homeless



Materials: 100g of double knitting yarn, a pair of 4mm (UK8) knitting needles

Cast on 120 stitches,

Row 1; (Knit 2, Purl 2) repeat to end

Repeat this row until knitting measures 30cm (12 inches)

Next row; (Knit 2 together) repeat to end of row

Next row; Purl to end

Repeat these 2 rows twice more and until you are left with 15 stitches.

Draw the yarn through the remaining 15 stitches, secure the yarn then sew up the seam.

The hats should be knitted in dark or muted colours and will be distributed to homeless and vulnerable people in Newcastle by The Peoples Kitchen.
